Greetings to all! I am pleased to announce that our County Executive Committee has prepared for our Biennial Organization Meeting, which is open to all registered Republican voters. This is an excellent opportunity to be actively engaged in the party whether it be as a member of the County and/or State Central Committee. Members are elected to two-year terms.

The Bernalillo County Central Committee (BCCC) is the governing body of the Republican Party of Bernalillo County, and the State Central Committee (SCC) is the governing body of RPNM. At the county level, we register voters, assist candidates in their campaign efforts, recruit candidates for office and volunteer at the grassroots level to build our party. If you would like to be more involved and help the Republican party, this is an excellent way at an entry level to help.

Due to the pandemic, we are forced to meet virtually.
